INVITATION FOR THE PRE-QUALIFICATION OF CONTRACTORS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF 10KM 330KV DC TRANSMISSION LINE FROM 330/132/33KV LEKKI SUBSTATION TO EKO ATLANTIC CITY AND 2X60MVA TRANSFORMERS 132/33KV GIS SUBSTATION -LAGOS STATE

1. **INTRODUCTION**

The Federal Government of Nigeria through Transmission Company of Nigeria (TCN), intends to prequalify contractors for the Engineering Design, Procurement, Manufacture, Supply, Construction & Commissioning of 330kV Double Circuit Transmission Line(10km) and 2 x60MVA, 132/33kV GIS Substations

Source of funding of Project: TCN-Euro Bond & AfDB Budget Support Facility

2. **SCOPE OF WORKS**

LOT 1: Construction of new 10km 330kV DC Transmission Line from the existing 330/132/33kV Lekki Substation to Eko Atlantic City, Lagos State.

LOT 2: Construction of new 2X60MVA, 132/33kV GIS Substation at Eko Atlantic City.

Details of the above descriptions and scope of work are contained in the Prequalification Documents.

3. **ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS (NIGERIAN COMPANIES ONLY)**

Suitable Companies are invited to participate in the prequalification exercise by submitting the following pre-requisite requirements:

- Certificate of Incorporation with the Corporate Affairs Commission (CAC) in Nigeria with forms C02 and C07).
- Current Tax Clearance Certificate for the past three Years (2016, 2017 and 2018) valid till 31st Dec. 2019
- Three years company Audited Financial Accounts duly stamped by a registered Auditor for the year (2016, 2017 and 2018)
- Evidence of current PENCOS compliance Certificate valid till 31st December 2019.
- Evidence of current Industrial Training Fund (ITF) certificate in compliance with the provision of Industrial training Fund (ITF) Valid till 31st December 2019.
- Evidence of Registration on the National Database of Federal Contractors, Consultants and Service Providers by submission of Interim Registration Report (IRR) expiring on 31/1/2020 or valid Certificate issued by BPP.
- Evidence of current Nigeria Social Insurance trust fund Compliance certificate valid till 31st December 2019.

4. **ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS (FOREIGN COMPANIES)**

- Evidence of Company Registration in Home country
- Evidence of Tax clearance certificate for past three (3) years (2016, 2017 & 2018)
- Three years Company Audited Account (2016, 2017 & 2018)

5. **QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS**

The under listed qualification requirements applies to both local and foreign companies, including joint ventures

- Minimum Average Annual Construction turnover over the past five (5) years as shown below:
 - Lot 1 – Ten Million US Dollars (US\$10,000,000.00)

- Lot 2 – Twenty-Seven Million US Dollars (US\$27,000,000.00)
- The Applicant shall demonstrate that it has access to, or has available liquid assets, unencumbered real assets, lines of credit, and other financial means (independent of any contractual advance payment) sufficient to meet the construction cash flow requirements estimated as follows:
 - Lot 1 – One Million, Two Hundred Thousand US Dollars (US\$1,200,000.00)
 - Lot 2 – Three Million, US Dollars (US\$3,000,000.00)
- Evidence of Similar Experience with contract awards, valuation certificate, job completion certificates and photograph of at least three (3) projects of similar nature (330KV and above) and complexity executed in the last five years each of minimum value as follows:
 - Lot 1-** Two Million, Five Hundred Thousand US Dollars (US\$2,500,000.00)
 - Lot 2-** Seven Million, Two Hundred Thousand US Dollars (US\$ 7,200,000.00)

It is required that two of the three contracts should be outside the bidders' home base (with at least one in Africa) for foreign bidders.

Final Taking Over Certificates from Clients including names, evidence of payment for such projects, addresses, valid e-mails and phone numbers of contact persons on each project must be attached.

- Company Profile including
 - Populated organizational structure and key professional staff with relevant experience on high voltage power lines and substations;
 - Availability of requisite and appropriate skills among key staff and persons to be engaged in the project;
- Submission of evidence of Local Content plan showing indigenous personnel participation, transfer of technology, capacity development and in-Country maintenance and support plan.
- Evidence of Works Equipment holdings or access to lease of Relevant equipment, machineries etc.
- Evidence of equipment/materials Manufacturer authorization
- Equipment Must comply with International standard (ISO 90001) on quality system model for quality assurance in design, development Production.
- Evidence of Environmental, Social, Health & Safety (ESHS) certification which must be valid at least two months before the closing date for the Request for Bids.
- For Joint Venture Partnerships, the joint venture agreements must be signed by all the parties, a copy of which must be attached. CAC, Tax Clearance Certificate, Pension Compliance Certificate, ITF Compliance Certificate, NSITF Compliance Certificate, IRR & Sworn Affidavit are compulsory for each JV partner).
- A sworn affidavit disclosing whether or not any officer of the relevant committee of Transmission Company of Nigeria or the Bureau of Public Procurement (BPP) is a former or present

Director/shareholder or has any Pecuniary interest in the bidder and to confirm that all information presented in this bid are true and correct in all particulars.

- l) All document for submission should be transmitted with company covering letter head paper bearing among others, Company registration number (RC) contact address, Telephone number, (GSM No.), email address.

The letter head paper must bear the names and nationality of the Directors of the company at the bottom of the page duly signed by the authorised officer of the firm.
